Class & Curriculum Structure



Classes for our Young 3's

Days/Time: Tuesday and Thursday 10-11:30AM

Ages: Child must be turning 3 by December 31st

Our young 3's class is a great way for a child to meet new friends and learn to feel comfortable while being separated from his/her parents for a short period of time. In this classroom, children are exposed to letters, numbers, shapes, colors. There is a great deal of creative play in this classroom while they learn to share and communicate with each other. Children in this classroom also participate in music class, indoor recess, and have snack time.

Classes for Children Three Years Old

Days/Time: Tuesday/Thursday, Wednesday/Friday, and Monday/Wednesday/Friday 9-11:30AM

Ages: Child must be 3 by September 1st

Our 3's program continues to work on social skills, follow multi-directions, and work together as a group and independently. The goals for this age group are to recognize and trace upper and lower-case letters. They also learn to recognize, count and trace numbers from 0-10. Children also learn how to identify shapes and colors, along with creating fun seasonal projects and activities. Each classroom has a center for hands-on activities for children to work together on the skills they are learning. By the end of the year, students are cutting, gluing, and tracing their names. There is a perfect balance of learning and creative play in the classrooms. Children also engage in Bible class, music class, indoor recess, and snack time.

Classes for Children Four Years Old

Days/Time: Monday/Wednesday/Friday, Tuesday/Friday, and Monday through Friday 9-11:30AM

Ages: Child must be 4 by September 1st

Our 4's program is a great balance of learning and play, but our main focus is to prepare the children for kindergarten. Children in this age group work on recognizing and printing uppercase and lowercase letters on their own. They also start learning how to print their first and last name independently, and print numbers 0-15. Phonemic Awareness is also worked on during the morning circle time, so each child has a better understanding of letter sounds, rhyming and nursery rhymes. Our 4's also work on knowing their address and phone numbers by the end of the year. Children work together on center activities to strengthen the skills they are working on independently in the classroom. They also participate in many fun, hands-on science experiments. Children in this age group also partake in Bible class, music class, indoor recess and snack time.
